

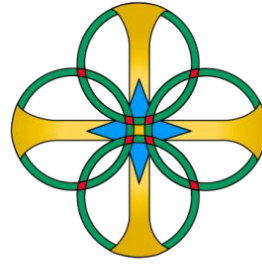
Wildcats Cheerleading

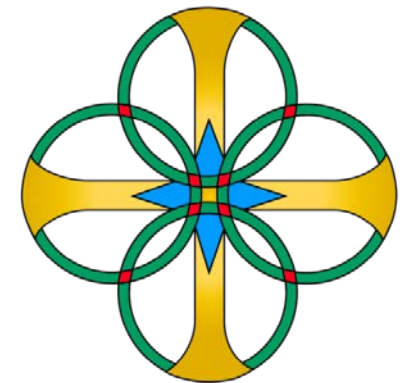
