For over 30 years, Christ Church and other area churches have served as helping hands to residents of Southwest Gwinnett County by generously responding to requests for food, personal items, and emergency financial aid through the NCM. The staff and volunteers of the NCM have been overwhelmed by the generous response from churches, businesses, and individuals during the past six months. Many thanks to all who have donated.

The NCM has been able to help many clients in Southwest Gwinnett County with food, rent, utilities, medical, and other needs during this on-going pandemic because of its many generous donors. Yet, many individuals and families continue to need help with food and other expenses. **Critical and On-going Food Items** needed this week include: Boxed potatoes, Canned meat (no tuna), Cereal, Canned corn, Mac and cheese, Meals in a can, Mixed veggies, Pasta and Pasta sauce, and Canned fruit. The NCM has refrigerated space so donations of fresh produce, dairy, and other perishable items can be accepted. In addition to food and monetary donations, the NCM needs toiletries, soap, laundry detergent, and feminine and paper products for their clients because these items can't be purchased with food stamps.

Donation hours at the NCM are Mon-Fri from 9am-4pm, Tues from 9am-7pm, Sat from 9am-12pm.
